**NOTICE OF ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING  
OF THE VOTERS OF THE  
NORTHERN ADIRONDACK CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**

**THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE NORTHERN ADIRONDACK CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT HEREBY GIVES NOTICE** that the Annual meeting of the qualified voters of said School District, County of Clinton, State of New York, will be held at the District's Polling Places in the Altona Town Hall, Churubusco Town Hall, Ellenburg (Middle/High School) and Lyon Mountain Fire Station on May 20, 2014, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, for the purpose of voting upon the propositions hereinafter set forth and for the election of members of the Board of Education.

Notice is also hereby given that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes may be obtained by any taxpayer in said School District at each schoolhouse in said School District in which school is maintained between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on each day other than a Saturday, Sunday or holiday during the fourteen days immediately preceding such meeting of voters.

Voting at such meeting on May 20, 2014 shall be by voting machines upon the matters set forth below:

1. To vote upon the adoption of a budget for said School District for the ensuing fiscal year;
2. To vote upon the following proposition:

Shall the Board of Education purchase and finance two (2) 66-passenger school buses at an estimated cost not to exceed \$213,427 including furnishings, fixtures and equipment required therefore, and levy a tax for the foregoing in the amount of \$213,427 which shall be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$213,427, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

Notice is hereby given that applications for absentee ballots for voting on such matters as may appear on the official ballot may be applied for at the office of the Clerk of said School District. Any such application must be received by the said Clerk at least seven days preceding the May 20, 2014 meeting of voters if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter or at least the day before such meeting of voters if the ballot is to be personally delivered to the voter. In addition, a list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the office of said Clerk during its regular hours on each of the five days prior to the day of such meeting of voters, except Saturday, Sunday or holiday.

Notice is hereby given that the Annual Election of a Member of the Board of Education of Northern Adirondack Central School District will be held, at the Annual Meeting, on Tuesday, May 20, 2014. Voting hours will be from 12:00 Noon to 8:00 PM at the Altona Town Hall, the Churubusco Town Hall, the Lyon Mountain Fire Station, and the MS/High School at Ellenburg.
