Re: 093600 55.-2-10.1
Kevin & Angel Wilcox

Section 550; Subd 2; Paragraph c of Real Property Tax Law states an incorrect entry of assessed valuation on an assessment roll or on a tax roll for a parcel which, except for a failure on the part of the assessor to act on a partial exemption, would be eligible for such partial exemption, constitutes a clerical error.

In this particular case, parcel 55.-2-10.1 should have received the Basic STAR exemption for the 2014-2015, 2015-2016, and 2016-2017 school taxes.

We request that the information provided by the Town of Ellenburg Assessor be used to determine the correct amount of refund due Kevin & Angel Wilcox.

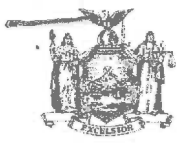
